Feeding and drinking, keeping notes up to date. Support with shopping, cooking and preparing meals. Keeping my bungalow clean and attending appointments and therapies with me. Social tasks to include going to the shops, clubs out for meals. Arranging for friends to visit me or for me to visit them.

Up to 2 people who can work as part of a team to cover weekend shifts available. Enabling independent living in own home and to remain part of the community participating in social outings and therapies. To be caring and respectful enabling him to have the support to have a high quality of life and enabled to live as independent as possible and supported to make own decisions.
